MERRIMAN, THE AUTHOR.

"With Edged Tools" was the first of the brilliant series of Merriman novels to be put on the stage. It ran 1079 nights in London and Britain generally, and the balance of thirteen hundred in Montreal, Toronto, Chicago, Winnipeg and Western Canada, to all of which cities it has, or will, return. This success is largely due to the fact that the same brilliant original All-Star English Company has been kept together and have, so to speak, grown into their parts. This is the first time in Canadian theatrical history that an original company, complete in every detail, has been brought from the other side, and that a big production will be presented at less than dollar-fifty prices. Merriman, the author, was a peculiar man. Modest to a degree, he was not of the class that sits in the office and writes news from the front. 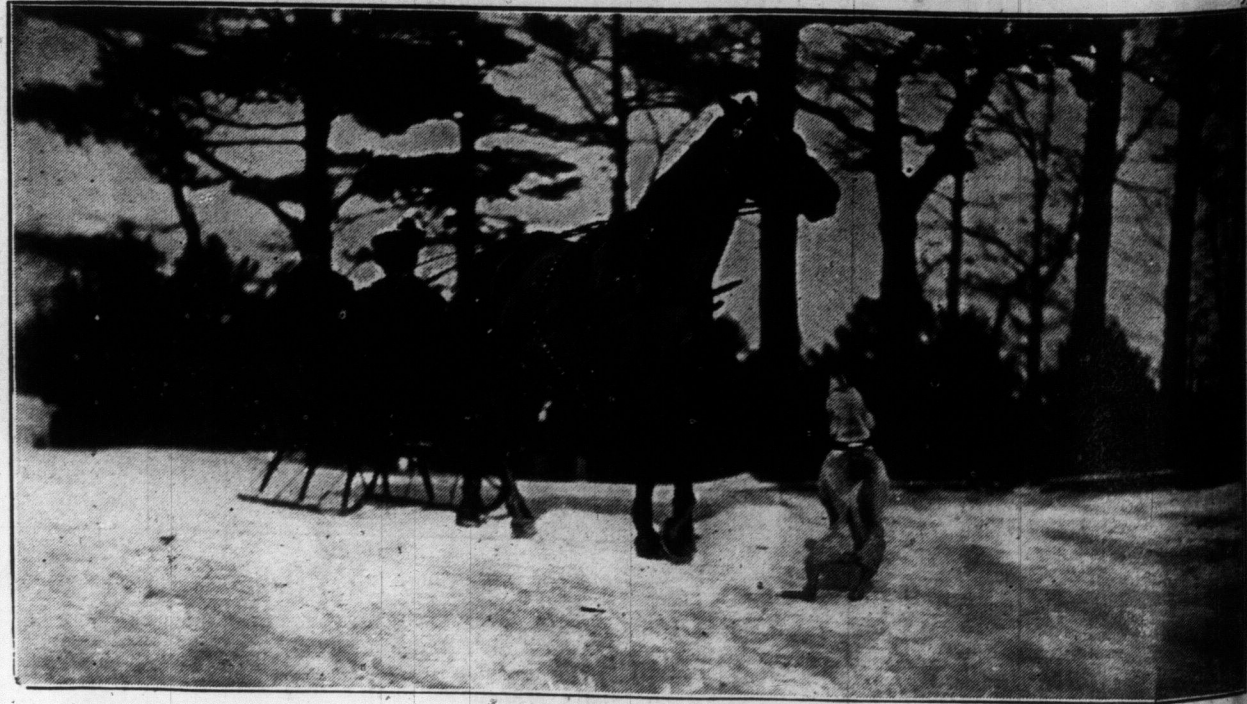
