13. When a student is sick, he is placed under the care of the Sisters of Charity, at his parents' expense.

14. The scholastic year is divided into four terms, viz: *First*, from the opening day to Nov. 15th; *Second*, from Nov. 15th to Feb. 1st; *Third*, from Feb. 1st to April 15th; *Fourth*, from April 15th to the beginning of vacation. Students, remaining in the college a portion of one or more of these quarters, will be required to pay the whole quarter or quarters. This rule applies, also, to those who cease being boarders, to become quarter-ditto. A new account will be opened with such students, from the time of such change, unless otherwise decided by the authorities of the college. In such cases, board and tuition only, will be required. For other expenses, see arts. 5 to 9.

16. No advances are made by the college for clothing, pocket money, etc., unless an equivalent sum be deposited in the hands of the Treasurer.
