**SMALL MAJORITY AGAINST
ACCEPTING OFFER MADE
WINNIPEG STREET RY. MEN**
Winnipeg, July 20.—By a majority of eight, and with about 800 men not voting, the Winnipeg street car men voted against accepting the ten per cent. increase in wages offered them by a board of arbitration. The vote was 481 against 473 in favor. Another ballot is to be taken this week on the question of striking to enforce a demand for a 20 per cent. wage increase.

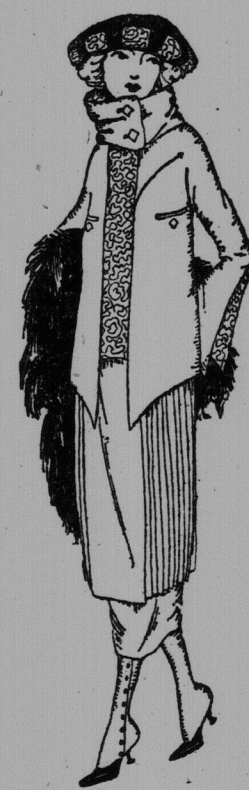
