Letter Followed Canadian Through France and Russia.

Harrison, Ont., March 8.—With the envelope tattered and torn and covered with cancellation stamps and forwarding addresses, a letter has reached Sergeant Frank Bingham here. Five years and seven months ago, on August 30, 1917, it left Harrison, bound for France, and during the time intervening had been travelling in search of the addressee. Sergeant Bingham was transferred to Northern Russia, the letter followed him there. For years it was lost to the world, but finally emerged from the land of the Soviet and arrived back in Harrison.

Bingham believes that the world's postal service has made a new speed record.

WOMAN IS FOUND HANGED.

Port Washington, L. I., March 8.—The body of a woman identified as Madeline Penowski, 30, employed at Amityville at the sanitarium of Dr. C. L. Markham, was found hanging from the limb of a tree on Beacon Hill, near here. Several boys had discovered the body on Thursday but did not report to the police.

Chief of Police F. J. Snow found the body hanging from a noose made of an apron string. A pocketbook with some change was found nearby and some change was found tucked in the waist. Physicians said the woman had been dead about five weeks. Dr. Markham said she had disappeared on Jan. 20.
