**INTERESTING HISTORICAL EVENT**  
The Nova Scotia Historical Society has unveiled a tablet in St. George's Church, Halifax, in the memory of Col. J. F. W. DesBarres.

The memorial is affixed to the north wall of the church, immediately above the tomb of DesBarres in the Crypt. The proceedings were interesting and impressive. The president, Archbishop Armistead, through whose exertions the tablet was secured, gave a brief introduction, recounting the labors and achievements of DesBarres; followed in a brief address by James S. Macdonald who closed his remarks by unveiling the tablet. The inscription gives a fair idea of the versatile genius of the man.

This Tablet Commemorates Col. Joseph Frederick Wallis DesBarres, Cartographer, Engineer, Administrator, Who Served in this Garrison as Captain of the Royal American Regiment of Foot, 1758.

Won Distinction at Louisburg, 1758. Aide-de-Camp to General Wolfe at Quebec, 1759. Surveyor General of the North Atlantic Coast, Preceptor of Capt. Cook, the Circumnavigator, Author of the Atlantic Neptune, Founder of Sydney, C. B., Lt. Gov. of Cape Breton and of Prince Edward Island, Barred Beneath this Church, Nov. 1, 1834.
