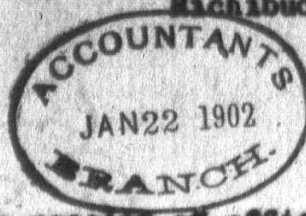

Sir:-

I have to acknowledge receipt of official letter of 5th December. And in reply I enclose statement marked A shewing \$54.02 of money of Burnt Church Band expended on Public building. I also enclose bills from John McDonland & Co., Donald Loggie and J. W. & J. Anderson shewing material purchased for building and unpaid.

The building is a plain wooden building 24 ft. by 28 ft. with posts 14 ft. feet; Eel attached 14 ft. by 20 ft.; shingled roof and walls, and sides to be clapboarded. Inside to be lathed and plastered upstairs and down.

In view of the fact that the building is already begun and in course of construction it will be more satisfactory to have the work put up by day labour.
