

Society, our venerable Bishop, to a crowded and attentive audience; after which the Assembly was addressed by the Revs. Thomas Webster, James Richardson, John Bailey, and Hiram Shepherd. Mr. Shepherd is a member of the Black River Conference of the Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States; he spoke of the Mission cause at some considerable length to the pleasure and edification of the congregation and the profit of the Society. At the conclusion of his eloquent address the collection was taken up, the annual subscriptions received, and several new members added to the Society. When it was proposed by Brother Shepherd the liberal hearted people of Trafalgar should constitute the Bishop and his Lady life members of the Society, which was accordingly done by a subscription of £2 10 each. It was then suggested by the Rev. Joseph H. Leonard that they should pay the same compliment to Brother Shepherd, and £2 10 was immediately subscribed for the purpose. The meeting was then concluded with singing a Missionary Hymn and Prayer by the Rev. James Richardson.
