the case and notify the member so engaged whether or not his policy shall remain valid, and what extra rate shall be paid during continuance of such dangerous or hazardous occupation.

ARTICLE 17.—AMENDMENTS.

SEC. 1.—No alterations or amendments shall be made to the Rules of this Society unless agreed upon by a two-thirds majority of those present at a meeting to be held as hereinafter provided.

SEC. 2.—Amendments to this Constitution may be made at any annual or special meeting of the R. W. the Provincial Grand Orange Lodge of Ontario West, notice of the proposed amendments having been previously sent to the Secretary at least thirty days before the meeting; and a copy of such notice shall be sent by the Secretary to the such District and County Master in Ontario West, and also to the members of the Benefit Society, at least six days before the meeting takes place. All amendments to be adopted by a two-thirds majority of the members of the Benefit Society present at such meeting.
