

or occupier shall have been ordered by the Surveyor of the roads to conform to this Regulation, until he or she shall be prosecuted, if it be then proved to the satisfaction of the Justices, in a Special Session, that the said Surveyor had allowed to the offender a reasonable and sufficient time to execute his order; provided that such fence only, if the same be made by a tenant, shall be allowed out of the rent, and that before beginning any such wall, palissade or fence, the said proprietor or occupier shall conform to the Second Article of these Regulations.

ART. 4. In all cases within the City and Suburbs, where it may be necessary to lay down materials for buildings or repairs, in any square, street, road or lane, the same shall be so laid down, as not to extend thereon more than one third of the breadth thereof; or if there be buildings or repairs to be made at the same time, opposite to each other, then the materials shall not extend therein, on each side, more than one sixth of the breadth thereof; and for that purpose all such materials shall be inclosed with a floored timber rail (*charpente sur sole.*) so as not to stop or obstruct the passage of the water running in the gutters. And previously to any such materials being laid down, application shall be made to the Surveyor of the Roads, who shall measure off the said third, or the said sixth (as the case
