

**COSENTINI, BARON GIROLAMO**:—Petition of Baron Girolamo Cosentini for an Act of naturalization, 41. Report of Notice, 48. Bill presented, 50. Referred, 64. Reported, 96. Committed, 108. Reported; Passed, 109. By the Senate, 205. R.A., 402. (49 Vic., c. 112.)

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**CRIMINAL LAW**:—Bill to amend the Criminal Law of Canada (Mr. Robertson, *Hastings*); Ordered; Presented, 44. Motion for second reading; Negatived, 249.

## DEBATES:

1. Select Committee appointed to supervise the Official Report of the Debates, 10. **FIRST REPORT**, recommending that the Order of the House respecting the printing of the Debates in Brevier type, octavo form, be not carried out, but that they be printed same as last year, 28. Concurred in, 40. **SECOND REPORT**, respecting translation of, and corrections to Speeches, and recommending the renewal of the contract for Binding with A. S. Woodburn, 155. Concurred in, 156. **THIRD REPORT**, recommending that the Debates be printed next Session by Messrs. MacLean, Roger & Co., &c., 321. Concurred in, 328.

2. Motion by Mr. Charlton:—1. That the growing practice of delivering Speeches of great length is a waste of valuable time and unreasonably lengthens the Sessions of Parliament, &c; 2. That it is expedient to adopt certain rules set forth to apply in future to the mode of conducting debates in the House; 3. That it shall be the duty of the Speaker to enforce the said rules; Amendment moved by Sir H. L. Langevin to strike out the second and third Resolutions; Agreed to, 167. Main motion, as amended, agreed to, 168.
