5. It shall be the duty of the said Corporation to lay before the Statement to Governor, &c. Governor of the Province, whenever called upon, a detailed statement of the number of Teachers employed in the various branches of instruc- 10 tion, the number of Scholars in attendance, the course of instruction pursued, and the moveable or immoveable property or Estate held by virtue of the present Act, and of the Revenue arising therefrom.
