his Hand and Seal, to constitute and appoint a fit and proper person, well skilled and practically acquainted with the timber trade of this Province, as Supervisor of Cullers, whose duty it shall be to manage, supervise and control, the culling, measuring and examination, of every description of lumber as hereinafter described; and who shall hold his office during pleasure; and shall himself, with two other responsible sureties, enter into bonds to Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, in the penal sum of three thousand pounds currency, for the faithful discharge of his duty; and shall, before entering on the duties of his office, take and subscribe the following oath, before any of Her Majesty's Justices of the Queen's Bench, that is to say:—

"I, A. B. do solemnly swear, that I will faithfully, truly and impartially, to the best of my skill and understanding, execute, do and perform, the office and duty of Supervisor of Cullers, according to the true intent and meaning of the Act, intituled, '*An Act to Regulate the Inspection and Measurement of Timber, Masts, Spars, Deals, Staves, and other articles of a like nature, in the Ports of Quebec and Montreal, and for other purposes relative to the same*;' That I will not either directly or indirectly, personally or by means of any other person or persons on my behalf, receive any fee, reward or gratuity whatever, by reason of any function of my office as Supervisor, except such as are allowed to me by the said Act; and that I will not, directly or indi-
