

of Sherbrooke, in like manner and form, as if the said last mentioned treasons, murders, felonies, misdemeanors, crimes and criminal offences had been done, committed, or perpetrated, within the said district of Sherbrooke. Provided always, that nothing therein contained shall in any manner abridge, alter, or affect the jurisdiction, power, and authority of the General Sessions of the Peace to be held in the said districts and United Districts of respectively or any of them, in pursuance of the provisions hereinbefore contained, which jurisdiction, power and authority shall and may be exercised, in the manner hereinbefore provided; any thing to the contrary thereof herein contained notwithstanding.

XXIX. And be it further ordained and enacted, that this Ordinance, and the several provisions herein contained, shall commence, and have execution and effect, at from and after such time, not later than the fifteenth day of May now next ensuing, as the Governor of this Province, by his Proclamation under the Great Seal thereof, shall appoint.

XXX. And be it further ordained and enacted, that the words "Governor of this Province," wherever the same occur in the foregoing enactments, shall be understood, as comprehending the Governor, or person authorised to execute the commission of Governor, within this Province, for the time being.

XXXI. And be it further ordained and enacted, that this Ordinance, and the provisions herein contained, shall not cease or expire on the first day of November, which will be in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and forty two, but shall be and remain a permanent and public law, and in force in this Province, until the same shall be repealed or altered by competent Legislative authority; and all Judges, Justices, and other persons therein concerned, shall take notice thereof, though the same be not specially pleaded.
