DAYS' WORKS IN THE FRENCH ARMY PHOTOGRAPHS.



In the small picture to the left at the top French soldiers in the Argonne are being taught to use trench bomb-throwers. To the right, a remarkable photograph of a French 220 m.m. gun in action, concealed in a forest. Next below to the left, French troops making a communication railway line at Decauville. The oval to the right shows French soldiers constructing shelters on the side of a small hill in the Argonne. The oval at the bottom is a splendid picture of a French trench in a village partly occupied by Germans. The last picture is of an old French couple who, after the great French offensive in the end of September, returned to find their home in ruins.
