The campus based service has been carefully scrutinized by a newly struck committee made up of SRC representatives and Ba Services personnel. Thus far several proposals for change are awaiting ratification, however, at least one item of the four part document has been confirmed as ratified.

2. There is now a three tiered structure which will in effect put a ceiling on the management fec currently being charged to the users of the student option format.
i) 1 to 3 bartenders, management fee will equal to 3 times total bartending costs.
ii) For an additional 1 or 2 bartenders, the management fee will equal 2 times total bartending costs.
iii) For additional bartenders, the charge will be equal to the actual cost of the additional bartenders. This new fee structure has been implemented, but is subject to further discussion and revision.
