Uplands, Ontario	1-8-42		Overcast. At 1030 hours, in Harvard 5290, Pilot Officer T.R. Shaw, with a student, LAC Prather, W.H., was giving instrument instruction. Pilot Officer Shaw told the student to spin the aircraft to the right and recover; recovery was started, but a spiral dive to right developed. Pilot Officer Shaw took over control, was blacked out a considerable portion of the time and recovered at approximately 2500 feet. He immediately returned to aerodrome. Rough manoeuvre resulted in the structural failure of the centre section and starboard wing. Accident occurred 10 miles west of main aerodrome. "B" category crash.
