are tabulated. Should not the total cost of these buildings and projects be tabulated as well, or is it intended that deductions are to be made in respect of the unpaid claims only. These buildings am projects have been apparently constructed for some years and if deductions are to be made on the total cost, such deductions should apparently be estimated from the date of their completion rather than from the lat January, 1933, many years after their construction.

I should be glad to have your observations with respect to these matters. In other respects the terms of the lease appear to be quite clear and satisfactory.
