



Ottawa 16th July, 1908.

Sir,

I beg to inform you that Dr P.H. Bryce, Chief Medical Officer of the Department will visit Manitoulin Island about the end of the present week. The object of his visit is to obtain information necessary to the institution of such measures as appear to be called for towards preventing the spread of tuberculosis amongst the Indians, and if possible, to stamp out the disease. Kindly advise the doctors appointed by the Department to attend the Indians. The Department desires that both you and they will do all ~~in your power~~ that is possible to aid Dr Bryce in accomplishing the object of his visit. I may add that similar instructions are being sent to Mr Thorburn.
