
Ottawa, 8th January, 1904.

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd ult., in which you complain that an Indian of the Hope tribe is endeavouring to obtain sole possession of a fishing station on the Fraser River, above Yale, which has been long held in common by yourself and others.

Mr. A.W. Vowell, Indian Superintendent at Victoria, has been requested to make special inquiry into this matter with the view of endeavouring to have it properly adjusted.
