


- Q.24 Will you tell the Court who you think he is?
A.24 Private Barrio, Sir.
- Q.25 What are your duties here?
A.25 When on duty in the guard room looking after the prisoners that are confined to the detention room.
- Q.26 Would you tell the Court, in your own words, just when you saw the accused last?
A.26 When I saw him last, Sir? I last saw him before I came in here this morning, Sir.
- Q.27 That perhaps is misleading. In the line of duty when did you last see him?
A.27 In the line of duty I last seen him this morning, Sir.
- Q.28 Would you tell the Court, in your own words, if you were on duty in the guard room and if the accused was turned over to you or not?
A.28 I was on duty 25-4-42 at 1930 hours when the Garrison Police of Saint John turned Barrio over to me and I placed him under close arrest.
