like to have the privilege of consulting with Mr.
Ditchburn when I get back to the Const on the point
suggested by Mr. Lene as to the authority of these
records in the official schedule. I can submit a
memorandum to you and a copy to Mr. Lene. I think that
will settle the basis of our claim, I don't really know.
THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.
