acquit, reprimand or expel him from the University, as the case may require.

17. In all cases of lighter offences for which a formal reprimand may be judged sufficient animadversion, the Principal with the Teachers, or if the Principal be not on the spot, the Professor with the Lecturers, or in the event of the augmentation of the number of Professors, the senior Professor presiding for the occasion, with the other Professors assisting, shall have the power of acquitting or reprimanding, the same previous formalities being observed, *mutatis mutandis*, as in the cases specified in the preceding Bye Laws.

18. The winter courses shall commence on the first Monday of November.

19. The summer courses shall commence on the first Tuesday of May.

## CHAPTER II.

Of the studies and qualifications of Students, wishing to obtain the Degree of Doctor in Medicine and Surgery at this University.

1. The Medical Degree granted by this University, shall be that of Doctor in Medicine and Surgery.

2. The students who are desirous of attending lectures at this University, must procure from the Registrar a matriculation ticket, before the 23d December of each year, for which ticket he shall give ten shillings.
