

VILLAGE OF MILFORD.

Is situated on Black Creek, in the Township of Marysburgh, two and a half miles from Prince Edward or South Bay, where is located a customs port of the same name. A considerable amount of the trade done here is derived from the vessels wintering over in the bay. It has excellent water privileges, and contains two grist mills, a post office, two stores and three taverns. Nearly every trade is here represented. Mail from Picton twice a week. Church of England service every Sunday; Methodist do.
