Summary of News.

WINNERS AND ANNAPOLIS RAILWAY.—The opening of the new railway line is now the order of the day. There is little doubt that the Annapolis and Seakville line will be opened on Monday next, the 6th inst., but rumor has reported that the remainder of the line between Seakville and Annapolis would not be finished until the spring. From advice received we believe this statement to be incorrect. A letter from the Superintendent, Mr. Vernon Smith, dated the 26th Nov., says: "The line from Seakville to Annapolis will be opened on the 12th of next month." We understand that the proprietors of the 'Empress' will withdraw their train from the Seakville route about the 10th inst., and run her to Annapolis instead, leaving her on Wednesdays and Saturdays at 8 a. m., and connecting with the Annapolis and Seakville train, where time will be arranged to suit. The trip from St. John to Seakville by steam and rail, will then be made in thirteen hours. From Seakville to St. John, the trip will be made in twelve hours, or one hour less. Passengers for England, leaving to catch the human steam-rail at Seakville on a Friday, will probably take the Wednesday morning boat, and spend a day or more in Halifax. St. John Telegram.
