*Refolved*, That the Remainder of the Funds of the laft Loan Acts, fhall and may be appropriated for the Payment of all fuch Sum or Sums already voted to be paid by this House, and for the Payment of which no Provision has hitherto been made by the General Assignment.

A Meffage came from his Honor the Lieutenant Governor, acquainting the Houfe, that he was in the Chair, and requiring the Attendance of the Houfe;

Accordingly Mr. Speaker and the Houfe, attended his Honor in the Council-Chamber, where he was pleafed to give his Affent to the following Bills, *viz*.

An Act for determining Differences by Arbitration.

An Act for giving like Remedy upon promiffory Notes, as is now ufed upon Bills of Exchange.

- An Act in Addition to and further Amendment of an Act, made in the 32d Year of his late Majefty's Reigr; intitled an Act relating to Treafons and Felonies.
- An Act for enabling the Sale of Goods diffrained for Rent.
- An Ast in Addition to and Amendment of an Ast made and passed in the *Third* Year of his prefent Majesty's Reign, intitled an Ast to enable the Inhabitants of the feveral Townships within this Province to maintain their Poor.
- An AEt in Addition to an Act made and passed in the Fifth Year of his present Majesty's Reign, intituled an AEt for the Choice of Town Officers and regulating Townships.
- An Act for taking special Bails in the Country upon Actions depending in his Majesty's Supream Court in this Province.
