DOMINION PARLIAMENT. Several Important Bills Introduced—Yesterday's Proceedings.

OTTAWA, Feb. 4. In the house of commons, to-day, Mr. Waldie, M. P., for Halton, and Mr. Laurier, M. P., for Provencher, were introduced.

Six John Thompson introduced a bill

Sir John Thompson introduced a bill to amend the franchise act, explaining that when the dominion voters' lists were issued revising officers to prepare supplementary lists containing additions or subtractions from the lists as sent to him from the government printing office. When these supplementary lists are printed, they will be returned to the revising officers, who are to post them up in prominent places, and fix a day for revision. The polling districts are to be subdivided so as to contain 250 instead of 200 votes.


