engaged in performing the dredging required of the said dredge will have a number of barges, lights, and cables for mooring purposes, the same being deposited on the shore on either side of the Channel, all of which will be used as required.

All masters of Steamers are cautioned to keep clear of said barges, lights and cables, so as not to prevent the work of the dredge, and loaded the paddles or propellers—as the above mentioned moorings will be in place when the dredge is there or not.

As what working it is not possible to shift the position of the dredge, it is requested to give it a wide berth so as to avoid collision.
