CANCER NOT **CURED BY THE** RADIO NEEDLE

tried out in Chicago: will prove cure for cancer were dampened Dr. Louis E. Schmidt who demonstrated the new process; said radio surgery had its limitations. It will not cure cancer; but can be used practically whereever the knife can. Dr. Schmidt and Dr. Wochinski his assistant operator; both express ed doubt that the new method wou. revolutionize surgery; or that would come into general practice; at least for a long time.

The chief advantage the radio needle has over the knife is that it prevents less of blood: unless large artery should be severed; in which case ligaments would have to Amundsen's be applied. The patient is thus saved the usual shock that follows major operations.
