Extra Postage.

On and after May the 17th, 1918, every prepaid letter and letter packet posted in Newfoundland, shall, in addition to the postage payable thereon under the Provision of the Post Office Act of 1891 and Acts in amendment thereafter, be chargeable with an EXTRA POSTAGE OF ONE CENT; thus a one-ounce letter will be three cents, etc.

In the case of letters from Labrador, the double tax will not be enforced in Newfoundland until after the arrival and distribution of the first mail by steamer from that coast.
