LOCAL MARKET.

London, Tuesday, May 30.
The market today was hardly up to the average for this day of the week, as the attendance of farmers and buyers was light and the supply of produce was very meager. The feature of the market was the brisk demand for what produce was offered.

Regarding the comments made in this morning's issue of the Free Press, by Mr. R. Roberts, of Sparta, in which he states that the scarcity of live hogs at present is due to the fact that farmers have been losing money raising hogs, the writer lays the blame for the small number of hogs on the market this season on the packers, as they were paying prices that meant a considerable loss to the farmers. A representative of a packing company states that Mr. Roberts' views are misleading. That the packers' side of the question is not at all sunshine. He pointed to the fact that the packing houses have paid little or no dividends the last few years. The causes of the fluctuations in price are simply supply and demand. When hogs are plentiful and the price of bacon low, prices must go up. When hogs are scarce there is too much competition in the packing business for any one firm to make a big pile of money.

Butter and Eggs—There was no change in the price of butter, what little was offered sold at 14c per dozen. Eggs were firm, at 14c to 15c per dozen. Grain—Outs were about the only kind of grain offered; sales were fairly brisk at 71 1/2 and 81 1/2 per bushel.

Hay and Straw—There were 20 loads of hay offered; sales were slow at \$7.50 per ton. Straw was offered, which sold at \$2.50 per ton.

Dressed Hogs—About 20 carcasses were on the square; sales were brisk, at \$8.25 per cwt.

There was not a great deal of poultry offered; prices were as quoted. Potatoes, apples, butchers' meats were sparingly offered; prices were as quoted.
