BRITTON OUTPOINTED  
BEANTOWN BATTLER

Bout Between Two Canadians Was Stopped in Fifth Round Owing to Heavy Punishment.

New York, Oct. 24.—Jack Britton, of Chicago, outpointed Freddie Duffy, of Boston, in a ten-round bout here tonight. While Duffy had the reach on Britton and is a rangy fighter, hard to get to, Britton had the better of him in every round but the fifth. In this round Duffy swung both hands to Britton's head and had the Chicagoan covering up.

Jim Savare, the Orange, N. J., heavy-weight, and Bill Keating, of North Dakota, were scheduled to go six rounds, but Referee "Young" Corbett stopped the bout at the end of the first round after Savare had knocked Keating to the floor. When the latter arose he staggered about the ring until the bell, when the referee declared the bout ended.

The referee also stopped the scheduled six-round exhibition between Tommy Hudson, of Windsor, Ont., and Johnny McCracken, of Toronto, both bantams. Hudson punished McCracken severely, and at the end of the fifth round the Toronto lad was in such bad shape that the bout was stopped.

SNODGRASS TELLS HOW  
IT FEELS TO MUFF BALL

Los Angeles, Oct. 24.—Fred Snodgrass, centre fielder for the New York Giants, whose muff of a fly ball in the tenth inning of the last game added the Boston Red Sox in winning the world's championship, arrived here today to spend the winter. He was accompanied by Art Stafer, utility infielder of the same team. Snodgrass will play with the Oxnard team during the winter.

Snodgrass said that he was "frozen to the marrow" when his fatal misplay occurred.

"I didn't seem to be able to hold the ball," he said. "It just dropped out of the glove, and that was all there was to it."

He said he was more sorry on Mathewson's account than his own.

JOHN GANZEL HURT  
WHILE HUNTING

Manager of Rochester Team Severely Cut About the Eye.

Kalamazoo, Mich., Oct. 24.—Manager John Ganzel, of the Rochester baseball club of the International League, was badly hurt over the right eye today while hunting in the woods near here. He was brought to his home in Kalamazoo, after receiving medical attention left at once for Rochester where he will be given special treatment. The injury is not expected to prove serious.

TWO TEAMS LAPPED  
IN SIX DAY RACE

Terrific Sprint at Unexpected Moment Gives Six Teams an Advantage—Only One Bad Spill.

Toronto, Oct. 25.—The fourth day of the six-day race at the Arena was by far the best in point of competition. Sprints were frequent throughout the day, and during a big jam just before 6 o'clock, the Diefenbacher-Gardellini and Loftus-Coburn teams were lapped. This was the first lap gained since the start of the race. As a result six teams are now tied for first place. Drobach and Lawrence have moved up to seventh place, a lap behind the leaders. Diefenbacher and Gardellini are one lap behind, and Loftus and Coburn are two laps to the rear.

Ryan and Thomas were again the bear-cats of the race throughout the day's racing, and were jumping continually.

In the sprint at the finish Jake Magin was the winner, with Ryan second and Lawrence third.

The Diefenbacher-Gardellini and Loftus-Coburn teams made many attempts to regain their lost laps, but were unsuccessful.

In a paced mile against time Elmer Collins rode in one minute forty-one and four-fifths seconds, which is the fastest mile that has been done on the track.

Kramer's exhibition quarter-mile was slower than usual. The best time was twenty-seven and one-half seconds.

In a half-mile motor race at two miles Jimmy Hunter defeated Charley Steyn by less than a foot.

Kilbane was at his best and repeatedly landed blows that stopped the attack of Albanese, who abandoned his usual defensive tactics.


Kilbane has announced that he intends going to California soon to defend his title in matches of twenty rounds or over.

A DRAW IN BOSTON

Former Featherweight Champ Was Held in Check by Jimmie Walsh, a Beantown Boxer.

Boston, Oct. 24.—Abe Attell, of San Francisco, former featherweight champion, and Jimmie Walsh, of Boston, fought twelve two-minute rounds to a draw before the Pilgrim Athletic Association tonight. Walsh insisted on the time of the rounds being shortened when Attell refused to get on the scales. The articles calling for both men to make weight.

Attell secured a lead in the early part of the contest by his lightning, frequently getting Walsh in a corner and beating a rapid tattoo on his stomach. After the seventh round Walsh kept the Californian at a distance with stiff left punches to the jaw.

"Well, boys, I have fought my last fight in the squared circle. When an inexperienced fighter like McCarty can stop me in two rounds I am satisfied that I am all in and should quit the game."
