WHEAT ENED 1/4 HIGHER AND PRO-VISLOUG WERE STRONG.—DECLINES ON REALIZING AND SUBSEQUENT RALLY—LIVERPOOL 1/4 LOWER FOR WHEAT.

Chicago, Jan. 31.

A moderate conservative estimate of the damage to the French wheat crop the damage not being general, but localized in the South, had some effects on the Liverpool openings which show ¼ decrease. March wheat opened to-day at 5-10¾, and May wheat at 5-10½. Other induences helped this decline. The bubonic plague has shut up exports aly from Rosario, but has left other Argentine ports doing their ordinary shipments, some of which have been received at Li erpool.
