EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to acknowledge receipt of your Note No. 166 of August 12, 1970, concerning the discussions which have taken place in the past several years between representatives of our two Governments regarding the need to broaden the coverage of the Arrangement Relating to Certificates of Airworthiness for Export effected by an Exchange of Notes of July 28, 1938, (1) to cover modifications made in one country to aircraft registered in the other.

I have the honour to inform you that my Government concurs in the amendments to the above Arrangements, as stated in your Note under reference. It is agreed, therefore, that your Note and this reply, which is authentic in English and French, shall constitute an agreement to amend the Arrangement Relating to Certificates of Airworthiness for Export, to enter into effect on the date of this reply.
