



EXCHANGE OF NOTES (DECEMBER 4, 1969) BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF CANADA AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY AMENDING THE SCHEDULE TO THE AIR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES OF SEPTEMBER 4, 1959

EXCELLENCY,

I have the honour to refer to the Air Transport Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany signed at Ottawa on September 4, 1959,⁽¹⁾ and to the Exchange of Notes, also dated September 4, 1959, establishing a Route Schedule for air service pursuant to paragraph (2) of Article II of the above-mentioned agreement.

In accordance with the agreement reached by civil aeronautical authorities of Canada and the Federal Republic of Germany meeting in Bonn from May 27 to May 29, 1969, I have the honour to propose that the Route Schedule incorporated in the Exchange of Notes of September 4, 1959, as amended by the Exchange of Notes dated December 10, 1965,⁽²⁾ be replaced by the Route Schedule described in the Annex to this Note.

I have the honour to inform you that the Government of Canada has approved this proposed new Route Schedule. I should be grateful if you would inform me whether the Government of the Federal Republic of Germany also agrees with this Route Schedule. If it does, this Note together with its annex, which is authentic in German, English, and French, and your reply, shall be regarded as constituting an agreement between our two Governments to enter into force on the day of your reply.
