Feb'y. 8—Whether arrangements have been made, or will be made, with the Food Analysts appointed under the Act, so that their services may be available to the public on payment of a small fee, as in similar Acts in Great Britain, so that information may be obtained by private individuals with regard to the quality of food offered for sale, or already sold, to aid the proper officers in carrying out prosecutions?

By the Honorable Mr. Read:-

8—That an humble address be presented to His Excellency the Governor General, praying that His Excellency will cause to be laid before this House copies of all advertisements, tenders, contracts, reports, and all ofther correspondence as well as all affidavits, in connection with the construction of Booms, Piers, &c., on the Gatineau River last winter, and the entire cost of the same.
