For the past four years McGill has been carrying on an exchange of student teachers with the National Committee for the Train ng of Teachers in Scotland.

Under this scheme a Scottish student comes here to study educational methods, etc., and a Canadian student is at the same time studying in Scotland.

McGill and the National Committee for the Training of Teachers in Scotland each contribute £300 a year.

Notification has been received from the Scottish Committee that they are terminating the exchange with McGill at the close of this session.

The Permanent Under-Secretary (Deputy Minister) of the Board of Education in England has intimated that England would be ready to take up the plan dropped by Scotland if we so desire, commencing September, 1930.

After considering the whole situation Prof. Clarke now agrees (April 1930)
