MARCH.—March (Latin *Martius*) was so named by the Romans in honor of Mars, their god of war. In this month the Gothic tribes went out on warlike expeditions. It answers to NISAN or ABIS (Neh. ii 1; Dent. xvi 1), the seventh of the civil, and the first of the sacred year of the Jews. By the Saxons it was named *Hlyd-monath*, the loud or windy month.
