

BILL.

An Act respecting Joint Stock Companies incorporated by Letters Patent.

Note.—The clause between brackets thus [] is proposed to be struck out at the third reading.

HER Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :

1. This Act may be cited as the "Canada Joint Stock Companies Letters Patent Act, 1869."

2. The following expressions, in this Act, and in all letters patent Interpretaand supplementary letters patent issued under the same, shall have the tion of the meaning hereby assigned to them, unless there is something in the words :-subject or context repugnant to such construction, that is to say :

10 1. The expression "the letters patent" means the letters patent "The letters incorporating a Company for any purpose contemplated by this Act; patent;"

6. The expression "shareholder" means every subscriber to or holder "Shareof stock in the Company, and extends to and includes the personal holder," representatives of the shareholder.

25 **3.** The Governor in Council may, by letters patent under the Companies great seal, grant a charter to any number of persons, not less than formed for five, who shall petition therefor, constituting such persons and others who may become shareholders in the company thereby created, a body incorporated corporate and politic, for any of the purposes or objects to which the by letters-30 exclusive Legislative authority of the Parliament of Canada extends, patent.
