XXV.—On the decease of any Member of the Association the Members shall assist at his Funeral in the usual mourning furnished by themselves.

XXVI.—If a Member leave at his decease a Widow, the Members who shall have been substituted in Causes pending at his decease shall conduct them to the profit of the widow and of the minor children, if any.

The Widow and Children shall be entitled to counsel, and every assistance that can be afforded by the profession, and that gratis. R
