With these convictions, we feel bound to labour with all our might for denominational advancement. The world is to be regenerated; but that result, ean only be brought about by God's blessing on the dissemination of New Testament truth and the establishment of New Testament policy. Let us give ourselves to the diffusion of truth;—let us live according to the truth;—and let us seek the Lord in earnest prayer for the continual outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Truth and prayer will conquer the world.

"Be not slothful, but followers of them who through faith and patience inherit the promises," Heb. vi. 12. "The noble army of martyrs"—says the grand old hymn—" praise thee." Oh what a glorious meeting there will be when the "fellowservants and brethren" of those who are now "under the altar" shall be fulfilled!"--" What are these which are arrayed in white robes? and whence eame they? * * These are they which came out of great tribulation, and have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. Therefore are they before the throne of God, and serve him day and night in his temple; and he that sitteth on the throne shall dwell among them. They shall hunger no more, neither thirst any more; neither shall the sun light on them, nor any heat. For the Lamb which is in the midst of the throne shall feed them, and shall lead them unto living fountains of waters; and God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes," Rev. vii. 13-17. May we form part of that blessed company!
