St. Petersburg. Dec. 19.-In spite of the statement that two army corps are being sent to the Baltic prov-inces, it is learned that no such number of troops is available. The government has sent two regiments from St. Petersburg in reply to the frantic appeals for reinforcements, but it is considered too dangerous to deplete the garrison of the capital any further during the present crisis, and the government can only await the arrival of the Cossacks and other troops which are being hurried forward by General Linevitch from Man-

ward by General Linevitch from Manchuria. In the measitime the governments fear is that the reposition, which is pushing forward to the Polish frontier, may arouse the Poles to an armed uprising.

Resiable details regarding the stabishment of the so-called kepublic of Kharkoff have at last arrived.
