The responsible officers of government, whether it be municipal, state or national, need and are entitled to the full and effective support of all citizens in the enforcing of laws.

"If the effort of Rotary should be effective in impressing this conception of the citizer's duty it will have performed a most useful service."

The first Rotary Club was organized in Chicago, February 23, 1906. There are now 1825 Rotary Clubs with a membership of approximately 90,000 in twenty-seven countries. The clubs are organized for the purpose of practicing and spreading the principles of service through the adoption of codes of ethical practices in all lines of business and professions, through work among boys to prepare them for citizenship and through utilizing the service idea in aiding and abetting all worthy causes for the general good of the communities in which the clubs are stablished.
