### WOMAN TIPPED PORTER TO GET INFORMATION FROM

#### HIM ABOUT DAVID RUSSELL

(Montreal, Sept. 30.—(Canadian Press)—That the woman who had registered at the Windsor Hotel as J. P. Patterson's wife had tipped a porter at the Windsor Hotel for information concerning the whereabouts of David Russell on the afternoon of their arrival in the city and just previous to the interview she had with the millionaire financier in the sitting room of the hotel, were the interesting revelations this morning in the suit which the financier is bringing against the Princeton Detective Agency for \$200,000.

Robert C. Smith, K.C., who has been mentioned in connection with the case, said that he was advised in an official capacity to go to Pittsburgh and investigate the character of the two people who posed as man and wife, and who Mr. Russell thought were endeavoring to work a badger game on the millionaire.

James Robinson, M.P.P., of Northumberland county, N. B., said that he had occasion to discuss many financial affairs with Mr. Russell during the month of October, when the alleged persecutions started and he always found him perfectly lucid and rational.

John A. Knight, a door porter at the Windsor, said he saw Mrs. Allan on October 16, lingering around the door of Mr. Russell's office in the Windsor Hotel. She finally tipped him a \$1.

"What was that for," said Mr. Campbell, who was conducting the plaintiff's case.

Mr. Geoffrey objected to the question Judge Archer settled the dispute by asking the question in a form that was acceptable to both and Mr. Knight replied that he had asked for information concerning Mr. Russell.

In the meantime, Mr. Knight swore, Patterson had been in the corridor of the Windsor Hotel from 2 p. m. till 4 o'clock.
