Patterson's wife had tipped a porter at the Windsor Hotel for information concerning the whereabouts of David Russell on the afternoon of their arrival in the city and just previous to the interveiw she had with the millionaire financier in the reading room of the hotel, were the interesting revelations this morning, in the suit which the financier is bringing against the Pinkerton Detective Agency for \$200,000.

Robert C. Smith, K.C., who has been mentioned in connection with the case, said that he was advised in an official capacity to go to Pittsburg and investigate the characters of the two people who posed as man and wife, and who Mr. Russell thought were endeavoring to work a badger game on him.
