Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 12th inst.  
No 55340. I beg to say that when I was at Shoal  
River Reserve last month, the Chief informed  
me that he never received his medal, and as for  
the other articles, he stated that they were  
promised him some time ago, by the Agent, but did  
not say when, this old man told me that he did  
not expect to live long, and would like these  
things before he died. You will understand when  
an Indian says he has been promised things, I  
find that only mean that he has asked for these  
things, no doubt this man has asked Mr. Logan  
for these articles and has taken for granted  
that he was promised them.
