at any port or place within the Province, whether any deaths have occurred on board during the voyage or passage; and if such be the case, that the bedding, clothes and wearing apparel of or used by the deceased, be not landed, till they have been thoroughly washed or at least steeped in clean water for 48 hours and then well dried.

13th. That the Local and other Boards and Committees of Health throughout the Province, do report to the Secretary of the Central Board, at least once a week the state of the Public Health in the City, Town or place for which they are appointed, and in the event of the prevalence of any Epedemic or Contagious disease in their respective localities, the nature of the disease and the number of deaths.
