and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That from and after the passing of this Act any Oranges or Lemons, the Produce of the *Azores* or the *Madeiras*, may be shipped and laden there for Exportation direct to any of the Ports of the *British* Colonies in *North America*, and may be imported into the said Ports in any *British*-built Ship or Vessel owned, registered, and navigated according to Law; any Law, Custom, or Usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
