I take the opportunity to acquaint your Honor that those two men I fonte for Inteligence to the Western Country have veturned, they went no farther than at the thiring Village there they met the different Chiefs of the Different Tribes particular the Delaware, from the White River which I intended they should go as far _ there found it was Meedles for Them to go any farther for they warnt of Those Chiefs wery thing, which Fransactions was gaing on at prefent - There is a party Jent out to the Missippi that will Feturn in The Spring Barly, where They suppose the French are. Shore Delawares and other think in reality there is a number of the French Now among the Southern Indians, which by the best Information we can get from them is, their defign is Certainly to advance to this quartor.

Tihewise the shownerse Chiefs Think it highly necessary for us the five nations to attend a council with them in the Spring, at the thinon Village to renew our Confederacy. They are apprehensive of the French Infiniation
