Please read Mr. Laird's memorandum, also Mr. Jean's in re-division of account 226 "Montreal Lake and Lac-la-Ronge".

The time has arrived, I think, when this account should be divided and the Capital and Interest apportioned to each Band on a fair basis.

Up to the present time, the "Interest" has almost entirely been expended for the benefit of the Montreal Lake Indians, but this should no longer continue, I think, in fact they should possibly make restitution to the Lac-la-Ronge Band of what they were not entitled to.
