We have received an application from the above mentioned for assistance towards the purchase of the property described and as this is situated within the Indian Reserve, we shall be pleased to learn from you as to whether assistance may be granted in this connection by this office.

Our applicant forwarded us an option obtained from John P. Wright, Indian Agent, Fort Frances, under date of the 17th of October last, offering this proposition to the Soldier Settlement Board for the sum of \$2089.27, but owing to conditions of the weather at that time, we were unable to have an inspection ordered upon the property and this case was held over until this Spring, and pending further instructions from our applicant if he was still of the same mind in locating in this neighborhood.
